

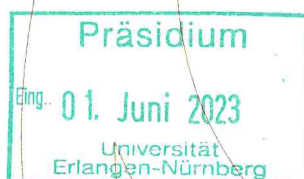

2024 Tang Prize in
Rule of Law

It is our pleasure and honor to invite you to nominate candidate(s) whom you deem most deserving of this Prize. Candidates should be individuals and/or organizations that have made significant contributions to the rule of law, reflecting not only the achievement of the candidate(s) in terms of the advancement of legal theory or practice, but also in the realization of the rule of law in contemporary societies through the influences or inspiration of the work of the candidate(s). Up to three laureates can share this award. As such, up to three candidates can be nominated in one nomination.

This biennial Prize will grant a cash award of NT\$40 million (around US\$1.3 million), plus a NT\$10 million grant (around US\$330,000) for further amplification of the laureate's endeavors related to Rule of Law. More information can be found in the enclosed brochure or at www.tang-prize.org.

During this cycle, nominations may be submitted via our online nomination system using the login ID at the bottom of this letter, or as a hardcopy nomination using registered (air)mail or our prepaid DHL courier service. Details on how to make a nomination are explained in the following page. Nominations must be submitted by **September 30, 2023**. To ensure the integrity of the nomination process, we cordially request that you treat your nomination as confidential. Self-nominations are not allowed. Individuals who have deceased are not eligible as nominees. For confidentiality reasons, please do not use fax, email, or phone to submit nominations. HOW TO MAKE A NOMINATION

- ◆ As the representative of the organization, you may authorize a delegate to assist in making a nomination, but your final approval is required for the nomination to be considered.
- ◆ We request that you treat your nomination as highly confidential. Other than with the designated delegate, please do not discuss your nomination with any other individual.

1 Online Nomination

- ◆ Please locate the **Login URL** and **Login ID** at the bottom of the invitation letter and activate your account using the provided URL before proceeding to the steps below to nominate.

1. Visit www.tang-prize.org and click the “Submit a Tang Prize Nomination” sidebar located on the right.



2. Select “Nomination System Login”.



3. Use the **Account name & Password** that you have created to access the nomination system.



4. Begin your nomination or designate a delegate.

- ◆ Your nomination will be saved and made available for reference during future cycles in the online system.
- ◆ If you were invited to nominate for different award categories, you only need to log in to one account. However, the nomination for each category needs to be submitted separately.

 2. Email your name, mailing address, and phone number to us at rol@tang-prize.org. We will send you a pre-paid shipping label and instructions on how to contact your local DHL agent.
- ◆ If you opt to use **postal mail**, please use registered mail if you are located outside of Taiwan to ensure that your submission reaches us.
